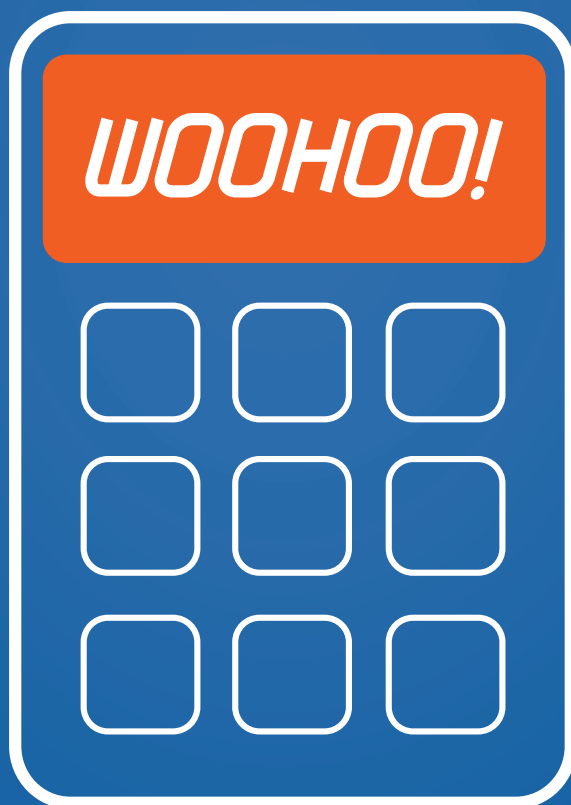

# FREE TAX PREP. FAST REFUND.

One out of five people who qualify for the EITC don't claim it. Be sure you do.

## What to Bring.

- For married filing joint, both spouses must be present
- All Forms W-2 and 1099
- Information for other income
- Information for all deductions/credits
- A copy of last year's tax return
- Proof of account for direct deposit of refund
- Social Security cards or Individual Taxpayer Identification notices/cards for you, your spouse, and/or dependents
- Proof of identification for yourself and/or your spouse
- Total paid to daycare provider and their Tax ID number
- Birth dates for you, spouse and/or dependents on the return
- Proof of foreign status if applying for ITIN
- Forms 1095-A, B or C (Affordable Health Care Statements)
- For prior year or returns, copies of Income Transcripts from IRS (and State, if applicable)
