Families: Application Open for Child Care Debt Relief



Do you have past due child care payments that are owed to a Hamilton County child care provider?

If so, the 4C for Children Hamilton County Child Care Debt Relief Fund



may be able to help you pay down or erase your child care debt.

If the debt was built up between March 1, 2020 and February 28, 2021 and your child care provider is located in Hamilton County, you are eligible to apply for help from the relief fund.

The application process is simple. Use your phone, tablet, PC or laptop to fill out an online application (also found at https://forms.4cforchildren.org/parents/nkoa.aspx) and submit it to 4C for Children by 11:59 p.m. on April 30, 2021.

Please Note

- Funding is limited and not guaranteed.
- If funding is granted, it may be in a lesser amount than requested. Funding decisions are the sole responsibility of 4C for Children.
- Families will be informed of funding decisions by June 11 and payments will be sent directly to child care providers by June 30.
- All Hamilton County child care programs both family child care and center-based licensed by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services are eligible to receive payments.
